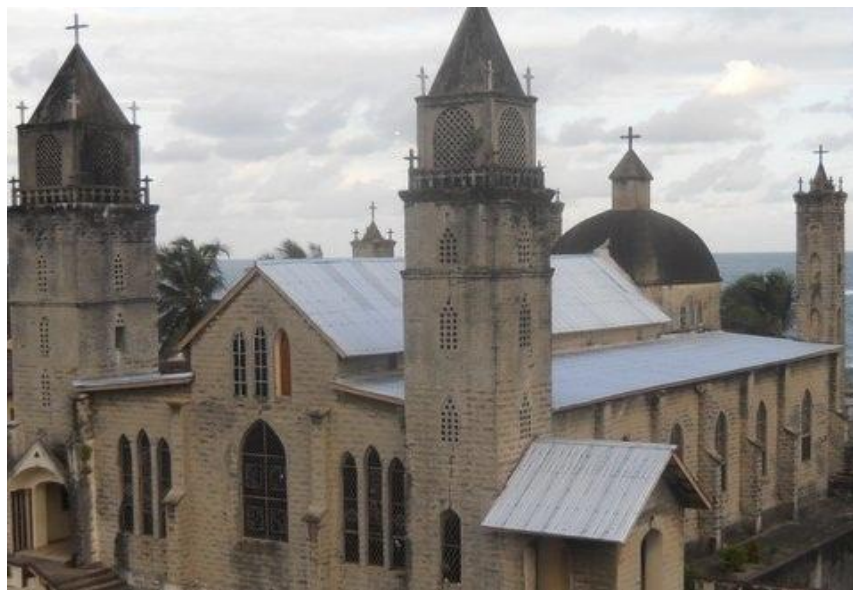


Before re-roofing.

What a historic edifice!!!! Look at the crosses way at the apex.
The original edifice was built in the 1800s under the direction of C.C. Hoffman (after whom Hoffman station Cape Palmas is named). It was built during the time of Bishop John Payne (the first bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church Liberia, after whom the library at Virginia Theological Seminary is named). However, this modern edifice was built in the 1900s. Funds are needed to restore this and other 1800s Historical Episcopal Churches in Liberia.
